Defibrillators

Three defibrillators have been installed and are now available for use 24/7. They are located at :

- The entrance to the Parish Council Office
- Adjacent to the entrance at Cronton Community Centre
- Cronton Motor Services Chapel Lane

The locations were decided on the need for a constant electrical supply to the cabinets.

Our thanks go to Cronton Community Centre for the great support they gave in siting and installing the cabinet at the centre.

Thanks also go to Mike Walton of Cronton Motor Services for allowing a cabinet to be sited at his premises.

A number of volunteers have come forward to receive training in the use of the defibrillators which we hope will be concluded soon.

The volunteers will be available to collect and operate a defibrillator should it be required. Further information will be provided once training is completed.

In the meantime if a defibrillator is required go to your nearest unit dial 999 and ask for the ambulance service. State your location and request the access code for the cabinet. The units are fully automatic and will give oral instructions on the safe operation of the unit. In the event of cardiac arrest it is vital that Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is started immediately.

Cronton Village Inspection, environment and policing

We at the Parish Council recently embarked upon a village inspection along with representatives including Ward Councillors, Knowsley Council officers, Police officers and a manager from Tarmac who are responsible for roadways, pathways and potholes etc.

Issues discussed included road and path repair, green space and local pathways maintenance, flooding and in particular Sandy Lane, speeding and parking issues and anti-social behaviour.

On the subject of anti-social behaviour we are still suffering from the backlash of youths having been dispersed by Cheshire Police and that has manifested itself in the form of a serious arson incident on the Pasture where in the children's play area a wooden constructed piece of play equipment was destroyed by fire.

We are having discussions at the highest level with Merseyside Police and other agencies to pursue solutions to this including the possibility of closing the park at key anti-social activity times.
