

St Anne,s Well

St Anne's Well is situated directly opposite the Unicorn Inn and is of significant historic interest to the village of Cronton as it was the original site of the "**Stocks**" and a local heritage landmark.

The site was refurbished over 25 years ago by English Heritage in conjunction with Knowsley Council and was subsequently maintained by Knowsley Council until circa 2013 when due to budget cuts maintenance was ceased and natural deterioration took its course.

In 2017 in conjunction with the **Cronton Pathways Project** heritage funding was sourced that enabled renewed refurbishment of the well and improvements to Coronation Gardens and the Cenotaph along with the reinstatement of the classic finger post on the corner of Chapel Lane.

Subsequently with some assistance from Knowsley Council local volunteers have kept it in excellent condition (if we want to name them Ken Bevan, John Foran, Pauline Rostance alongside donations from Cronton Garden Centre) and it is highly recommended that you view this very important part of our local history.
