**The Memorial Garden at 7 00 pm**

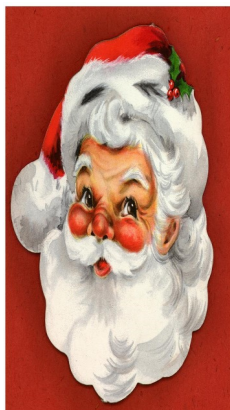
Two children will light the tree one from each primary school every one is welcome to attend this event .
