Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if you are over 18, a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any member state of the European Union at the day of your application and meet at least one of the following four qualifications:

- (a) You are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the parish of Cronton at the day of your application onwards.
- (b) You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish area during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your application.
- c) Your main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the day of your application has been in the parish area.
- (d) You have lived in the parish area or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your application.
